Innocoat Eco Form Release

Innocoat Eco Form Release is an environmentally friendly, dilutable plant oil based release agent for form release and equipment protection when working with concrete.

Description

Innocoat Eco Form Release is a concentrate form release agent surface that prevents adherence of concrete to timber & metal formwork, molds & equipment. Being plant oil based, Eco Form Release is safe on the environment and to use.

Features

- Supplied in concentrate form and to be diluted with water. No nasty chemicals!
- VOC free and safe to use
- Can be sprayed with a garden sprayer or mixed in bucket to be brushed on.
- Environmentally friendly, 100% Biodegradable.
- Diluted product left over may separate after a time, but a simple shake/stir will re-mix. No waste.
- Being a concentrate with minimal waste Eco Form Release is extremely cost effective.

Cautions

- Trial Product for Evaluation & Feedback – Potential further dilution rates and potential other benefits still to be confirmed.

Innocoat Eco Form Release

Application

- Shake well before use.
- Dilute 1 part Eco Form Release with 2 parts water (Dilution rate could be higher – TBC) Stir or shake gently to blend thoroughly. Can be mixed in sprayer unit or bucket.
- Spray, brush or wipe diluted Eco Form Release onto formwork, mould etc. Ensure full coverage. NB: only a light application is necessary.
- If being used to protect equipment further dilution is recommended.
- Left over diluted product is easily remixed, therefore no wasted product. Just leave and top-up as necessary

Clean-Up Not usually necessary but equipment can be cleaned with warm water.

Storage and Handling

Handling : Suitable protective clothing must be worn – Refer Personal Protective Equipment section

Storage : Store in cool, dry, well ventilated place in original container. Store out of reach of children.

Do not expose to direct sunlight in storage

Personal Protective Equipment

Eyes : Avoid contact with eyes. Avoid splashes.

Skin : Protective gloves and clothing are not normally necessary.

Respiratory : A respirator is not required under normal use.

First Aid
